HOW TO USE THE WORLD CHARGER WITH PLUG-PINS

- Only one plug-type can be selected by sliding the button. Other plug-pins are locked automatically.
- You can use the plug pin and the USB ports at the same time.

United Kindom

Depress the button and slide to the left for UK plug compatibility. Pull the insulated ground pin out of the housing.



United States / Australia

Depress the button and slide to the right for US or AUST plug compatibility. Make sure the contact blades are turned to the parallel position.



Europe

Depress the button with slide to the central position for EU plug compatibility.



LED power indicator

When the World Charger is plugged into a wall socket the blue indicator light illuminates.

We will not assume, nor authorize any person to assume for us, any other liability in connection with the sales of our products.

2. Warranty period:

The warranty period for the WakaWaka product is 2 years. The warranty period starts on the purchase date by the original purchaser. The sales receipt from

this purchase, or other reasonable documentary proof, is required in order to establish the start date of the warranty period.

3. Remedy:

WakaWaka will repair or replace (at WakaWaka's option and expense) any WakaWaka product that fails to operate during the applicable warranty period due to a defect in workmanship or material.

4. Exclusions:

WakaWaka's warranty does not apply to any product that is misused, abused, modified, damaged by accident, or used for anything other than normal consumer use as authorized in WakaWaka's then-current product literature.
